



CALL FOR ART(IVISM) – JANE GOODALL INSTITUT AUSTRIA

To mark the 85th birthday of Dr. Jane Goodall this year, the Jane Goodall Institut - Austria (JGI-A) has come up with a unique way to celebrate this special day and to gift Dr. Goodall with what is dearest to her heart: the funding of her lifelong mission to protect chimps and to empower people to make a difference for all living things.

Upon Dr. Jane Goodall's visit to Vienna, Austria on 10. September 2019, the JGI-A will host an exclusive charity exhibition of art work, which will be auctioned during the evening event in the presence of Dr. Goodall. So, if you want to be part of the change, become an active member of the JGI community and raise not only funds but also awareness, this call for art is for you!

The theme of this call is **#BeJane** and it should be a reflection of how the artist feels inspired by Dr. Jane Goodall and her work. It is an international call and all mediums are welcome (textiles, fine art, metal, sculpture, wood, photography, fiber). A jury of seven members of the JGI-A will select the artwork and overlook the silent auction during the evening. All funds raised through the sale of the artwork will go 100% to the projects of the Jane Goodall Institut - Austria.

All selected artists will receive a signed photograph of Dr. Jane Goodall holding their entered artwork, as a token of appreciation and an unforgettable memory.

DESCRIPTION, SUBMISSION AND SELECTION CRITERIA

Every individual has a role to play. Every individual makes a difference."

Art has an important and powerful role in activism, or so called activism. It gives the artist the chance to express their viewpoint, share inspiration and raise awareness. Dr. Jane Goodall appreciates art as a medium for the individual to be part of the change they want to see in the world.



#BeJane is an international juried exhibition open to all amateur and practicing artists in the following categories:

1) MEDIUM

- Accepted medium: textiles, metal work, wood, sculptures, photography, fiber and fine art (2D & 3D), original artwork only (no prints), framed where applicable
- max. height: 50cm, max. width: 50cm

2) ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- One piece per artist may be entered
- Three photographs of the submitted artwork (no larger than 2MB each). One photo of the full body of work (ideally as you wish to see it presented), two photos of details/close ups.
- Artist statement & short biography (please state how Dr. Goodall has inspired you)
- Measurements of the entered piece (height, width, length)
- If the artwork is selected, a photo of the artist will be required
- No entry FEE
- Submissions will be made via email to art@janegoodall.at

3) JURY & SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants will need to take the above criteria into account as it provides the key guidelines for the selection process.

The jury consists of the members of the executive and non-executive directors of the board as well as practicing artists. Selection will initially be made by the jury from digital images and will ask for the successful applicants to send in the selected pieces. The jury reserves the right to decline works on viewing, if they do not match the standards.

All entrants will be advised of the jury's decision by 15. July 2019 via email.

Entrants selected for the exhibition will be awarded with a signed photograph of Dr. Jane Goodall holding the original artwork. The duration of the exhibition and the silent auction will be for one evening only, held at the 'Meinls RÖSTHALLE' during a live lecture from Dr. Jane Goodall on 10. September 2019 in Vienna, Austria. All successful entrants are cordially invited to attend the evening event and receive a free ticket of admission.

4) SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- All work entered must reflect the theme of **#BeJane**
- All work entered is the original work of the artist
- All successful applicants grant permission to the JGI-A to use the submitted photographs of artwork for catalogue & marketing purposes
- All successful applicants are asked to have their work professionally packaged & insured until it is delivered to the advised postal address.
- All successful applicants give their permission to the JGI-A to keep their artwork and make it available for sale at later events, in case of no bids during the auction
- Successful applicants agree to donate their art 100% to the JGI-A for raising funds during the exhibition **#BeJane** (or a later event)

5) DELIVERY OF WORK

Successful applicants will be asked to ensure the arrival of the selected work by 20. August 2019 via postal/courier service or hand delivery. Addresses will be communicated after the selection process.
